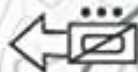

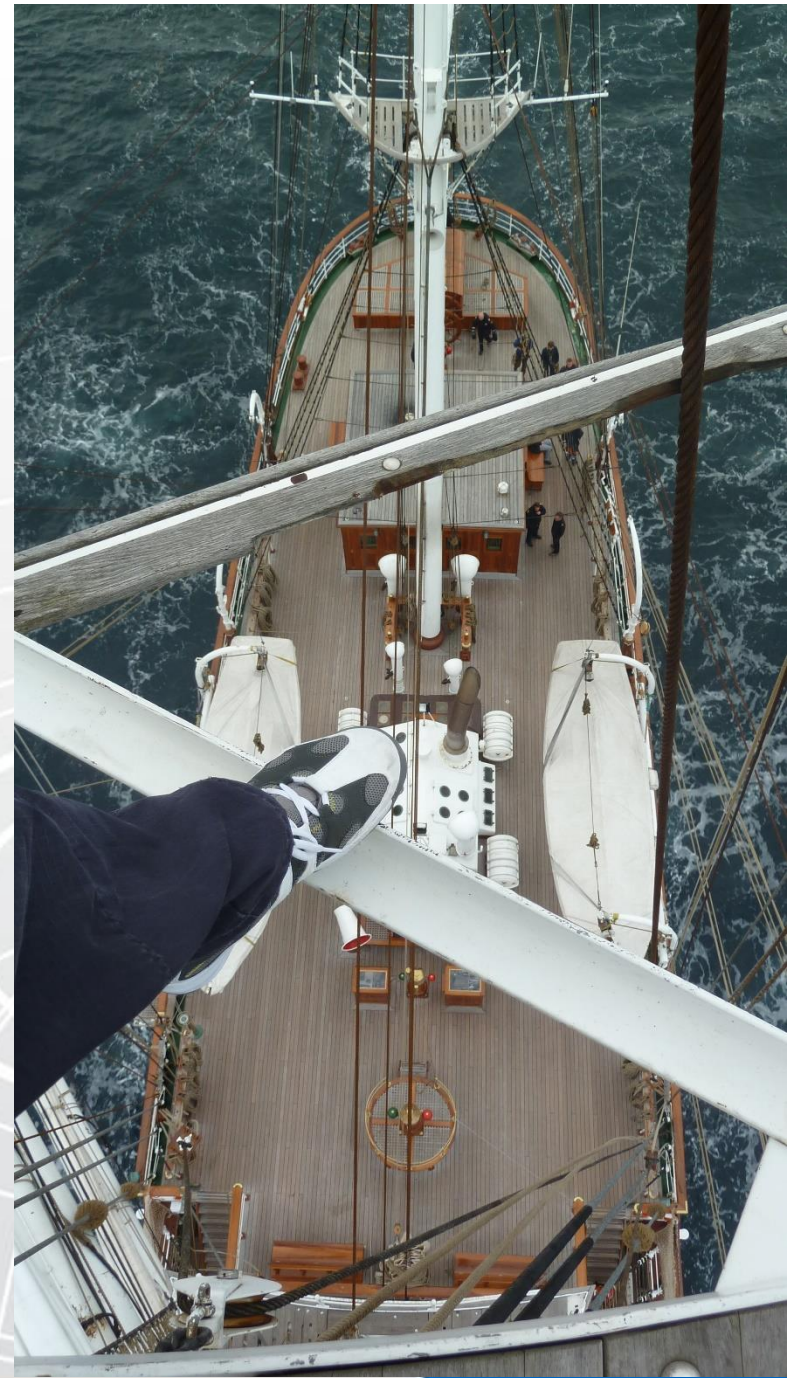

Teamwork in progress developing autonomy



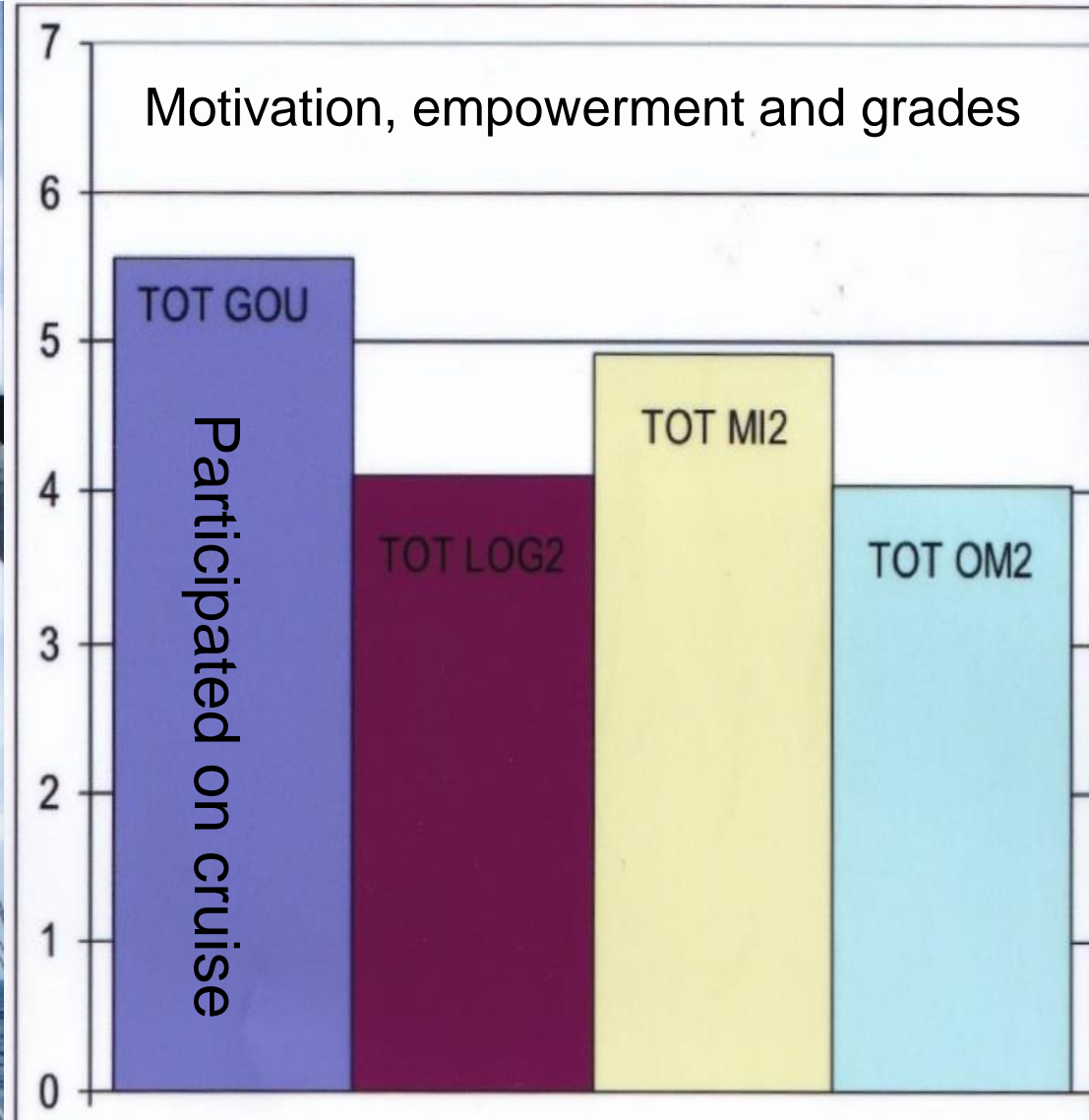


4 Cadet statements
