### Positive aspects

- Teaching/Learning did not stop
- Students' availability to learn and present assignments
- Less peer pressure among students
- Smaller classes
- Students' ability to deal with technology
- Revisiting concepts (e-learning/b-learning vs Classroom-based)





#### Aspects to improve

- Interaction
- Lack of Internet signal
- Teachers did not master the tools
- Pair and Group work monitoring
- The teaching materials available were not adjusted for online teaching
- Larger classes: the use of cameras interfered with internet connection
- Reliability of testing





#### Observations and Lessons Identified

- More investment in teacher training on online teaching tools is needed;
- A Plan B must be ready;
- Online teaching demands more skilled human resources.
